

Orientation Checklist: Must be completed prior to using QRA Equipment

- _____ 1.) Orientation to boathouse and equipment with member of QRA Board or person designated by board
- Explanation of policies surrounding boat damage or breakage
 - Rower is responsible for cost up to deductible (\$500)
 - Rower must contact board or Bay Captain
 - Rower must leave note indicating boat is damaged, preferably remove seat to make boat unrowable
 - Orientation to Equipment (Club vs. Private)
 - Explanation of Boat Reservation List
 - Explanation of Boat Log Book (importance of signing in and out)
 - Use of lights
- _____ 2.) If using QRA equipment,
- All new members must pass Captain's Test to use Hudson 1x, Wintech 1x, Hudson 2x and Wintech 2x)
 - If does not pass Captain's Test or has limited sculling experience (to be determined at discretion of board) then must complete at least 60 miles in Vespolis, Herka or Gig
- _____ 3.) Read Lake Quinsigamond Safety Rules and Membership Manual
- _____ 4.) Fill out Application and send Dues to Treasurer
